## **Assumption of Risk**

I understand and accept that outdoor activities such as sea kayaking expose me to many hazards which may occur at locations remote in either time or distance or both from health care facilities equipped to handle water sports injuries and physicians trained and experienced to handle such injuries. Some of the dangers and risks which may be present or may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Using paddles, ropes, and unfamiliar outdoor equipment.

- Human made objects in the water, including but not limited to ropes, bridge pilings, metal, or
  junk and other water craft.
- Carrying kayaks
- The forces of nature including lightning, weather changes, water level changes and others not named.
- The physical exertion associated with paddling and carrying equipment on land.
- Riding in a vehicle in case of transportation due to emergency.
- Hypothermia.

I acknowledge that the enjoyment and excitement of outdoor activities is derived in part from the inherent risks incurred by this activity beyond the accepted safety of life at home or work. These inherent risks contribute to such enjoyment and excitement and are reason for my participation. I am solely responsible for deciding to participate and continue in this program.

I agree to obey all Tree Top Summer Camp's rules and guidelines.

I assume all risks and understand my responsibility in decision making.
